## THIS WEEK: MISSION UPDATE

We have some exciting news to share with you regarding our plans to start our Expositors Bible School at our church. But I will save that to the end of the newsletter just to feed your curiosity.

Baby Ramos #2: This week we went to the doctor for our last appointment before Olivia's birth. Both mommy and the baby are doing fine. However, the baby is disproportionate to Kesia's body and will not fit for natural birth. This will require a Caesarean, but since the hospital prioritizes natural birth and is prohibited to make Caesareans by choice, they have to wait until Kesia goes into labor or until the due date, which is April 6th, whatever happens first. Continue to pray for Kesia that she will keep calm and have a safe delivery.

Teaching Ministry: Classes are going great and the semester is progressing quickly at both SIBIMA seminary and Antioch Bible Institute. I started receiving the first projects from my intermediate Greek students and applied the first general exam for my beginning Greek students. For my joy and satisfaction, I could see that the students are working hard and learning fast. I praise God for having excellent teaching material for both classes available in Portuguese, which makes my job easier and more effective. Keep these students in your prayers. I envision that some of them will pursue further training for ministry and become our students when we start the Expositors Bible School.

At our church we continue to have a blessed time of fellowship and good food at our bible study. The group has grown and last time we had 6 couples plus the kiddos. We are still going verse by verse through 1 Peter, with each man having an opportunity to lead the time of study of God's Word alternately.

**Expositors Bible School:** As you may already know our biggest plan and dream is to start a seminary at our church to train faithful Bible expositors and, Lord willing, join the TMAI fellowship of schools. In the last few weeks we have taken some big steps in that direction. In a meeting with Pr. Jenuan and Pr. Humberto we have sketched our curriculum and we will seek to refine it over the next months. We also have got in contact with several men both in Brazil and in the US who agreed to be part of our faculty. So we already have an excellent line up of resident, adjunct, and visiting professors.

More exciting of all, we might have gotten much earlier than we expected the second TMS alumnus to compose our resident faculty and fulfill one of TMAI membership requirements. Matthew Carroll, who currently lives in Goiania, has accepted our invitation to join our team and is in touch with his local leadership about that. If everything goes alright (and looks like it will), he and his family would be able to move to Fortaleza in November, right on time for the launching of our school in January 2016. Pray for Matthew and Elsiene, that the Lord will confirm their desire to join us and give them a smooth transition.

Still regarding EBS (EBEx in Portuguese), I am currently working with Pr. Jenuan on producing content for our website which we intend to have launched by June, before the two conferences we will have. The church is also almost certain to buy and move to a new property where Pr. Jenuan envisions to house a center with multiple ministries including a new and bigger church building, our missions agency's headquarters with apartments for missionaries on furlough, a biblical counseling center, a training center for church planting and revitalization, and EBEx. As part of that project, two ABWE missionary families are also planning to move to Fortaleza still this year. Pr. Jenuan is a man of great faith and ambition for God's glory and I am privileged to work with him. Pray for this big project, that God will provide what is necessary and that He will be glorified in all we do.
