THIS WEEK: FROM THE ELDERS

Making a Difference - The Parenting Conference

God's grace and provision for FHCC is often lavished upon us. One of the best and most recent which He made for us individually and collectively was the parenting conference we were able to experience at the beginning of this month.

What was the parenting conference? Well, for those that were not there, let me tell you about it. Chris Hamilton came to us from Grace Community Church in Sun Valley California and presented to us the Biblical description of, and commands for, parenting as Christian parents. He has considerable experience from volunteering in the various ministries to youth and parents in the church. He has carefully studied God's word about parenting and has used what he learned, both in ministry and his own family. With skill and clarity, he presented to us a Biblical foundation for parenting in general, as well as specific insights into raising boys, raising girls, and being parents and even grandparents.

If you were there, I don't have to tell you about his quality presentations. I am sure we all benefitted from Chris showing us the scriptures that set the foundation of parenting being to train children to fear God, embrace the wisdom of God, obey both God and earthly authorities, and to repent when wrongs are committed. I particularly valued his discussion showing that "being sorry" is not being repentant and can even be a face-saving way to avoid repentance.

So, why am I reminding you about the conference? Well there are two reasons. First of all, it is easy to be greatly impressed with good teaching and insight from God's word, and then let it end there. That would be a tragedy. If you attended the conference, I would ask you to name one specific action you have taken to implement what you learned. How is it going? Is the implementation now effective, or do you need to renew your plan or efforts? Are you and your spouse both committed to see good change occur? If you have a good example, what would be your next action to continue growing and being sanctified as a parent? Secondly, if you did not attend the conference, or if you need to remind yourself of what was presented, you have a great opportunity. The sessions were both audio and video recorded and are on our web site. Under "Resources" click on "Other Audio" or "Video" and then on the sessions. Your challenge is to make the most of this excellent resource.
